Authority in the Church, including primacy and infallibility, was discussed at a meeting of the Anglican/Roman Catholic International Commission in Oxford this week. The basic question facing the Commission was how the Christian Church is kept faithful to the truth of the Gospel. Traditionally Anglicans and Roman Catholics have explained this process in different ways. The Commission has tried to go behind these contrasting expressions to find out to what extent there is a shared understanding.
