Authority in the Church, including primacy and infallibility, was discussed at a meeting of the Anglican/Roman Catholic International Commission in Oxford this week. The basic question facing the Commission was how the Christian Church is kept faithful to the truth of the Gospel. Traditionally Anglicans and Roman Catholics have explained this process in different ways. The Commission went behind these contrasting expressions to find out to what extent there is a shared understanding. The progress made at Oxford encourages the Commission to look forward to its meeting next year, and to continuing work in preparation for it.
