We suggest that our intended meaning might have been more clearly stated by saying "the central truths, the truths of salvation". The word "central" was not intended to raise issues about which truths of salvation were more important that others.

what we were concerned to say was that not every definition of every council could be or has been thought to be permanently binding upon the faithful. Such binding force applies only to truths of calvation.
