The Fifth Full Meeting of the Anglican/Roman Catholic International Commission will be held at St. Augustine's College, Canterbury, from Tuesday, August 28th - Thursday, September 6th. TRAVEL

Those arriving at Heathrow are advised to take the airport bus to the London Terminals. The BOAC and Pan Am Terminals are only a few minutes' walk from Victoria Station. TWA's Terminal is in High Street, Kensington, and a taxi should be taken from there to Victoria Station. Those arriving at the West London Air Terminal in Cromwell Road on flights of BEA, Alitalia, etc. are advised to take a taxi or the Underground from Gloucester Road Station (a short walk from the Terminal) to Victoria Station.

For travel from London the train from Victoria to Canterbury East is the better one. Trains leave Victoria throughout the day at 10 and 40 minutes past the hour and arrive at Canterbury East approximately lhr. 25 minutes later. From there a taxi may be taken to St. Augustine's College. [There are also trains from Charing Cross and Waterloo to Canterbury West, every hour on the hour and at three minutes past the hour respectively, arriving at Canterbury West approximately lhr. 25 minutes later.]

Those wishing to bring their own cars to Canterbury may use the College car park during the Conference.
