ANGLICAN/ROLAN CATHOLIC JOINT PREPARATORY CONTISSION SECOND MEETING TO BE HELD IN ENGLAND

The second meeting of the Anglican/Roman Catholic Joint Preparatory Commission will be held in England at Huntercombe Manor, Taplow, Maidenhead, Berkshire, from August 30 to September 4, 1967.

All the Anglican and Roman Catholic delegates who attended the first meeting of this Commission in Gazzada in January this year will be present. In addition, the Anglican delegation at the second meeting will include the Right Rev. H.R. McAdoo, Bishop of Ossory, Ferns and Leighlin, from the Church of Ireland, and the Rev. Dr. A.T. Mollegen, of the Protestant Episcopal Theological Seminary, Virginia, from the Episcopal Church in the United States of America.

The Roman Catholic delegation will be increased by the addition of the Right Rev. Christopher Butler, O.S.B., Auxiliary Bishop of Westminster, and the Rev. Father Camillus Hay, of the House of Theological Studies, St. Paschal College, from Australia.

In addition to the Anglican and Roman Catholic members, the Rev. Dr. Harding Meyer will be present as an Observer from the World Council of Churches.
