

After the meeting of "Christians for Europe" this afternoon I had a talk with John Arnold.

1. There would be some discussion of the Georgi Vins petition tomorrow at the meeting of the EWRAC under the heading "David Hathaway".
2. It seemed best to leave discussion of Georgia for the March meeting of EWRAC. I had anyway not yet read Peter Reddaway's article in R.C.L.
3. Consultation on the Ordination of Women. (Also discussed this afternoon at CFR with Christopher Hill and David Greig of BMU). It appeared that initiative should now be taken by CFR in consultation with BMU and BCC/DEA (Martin Conway) and following personal consultations which I had had in various places in November and December 1975. We thought that there might be three informal consultations of as representative a group of people from Great Britain as possible of the various Christian traditions (not forgetting the Old Catholics). These might take place in the Conference Room at Lambeth Palace, and at the third the Archbishop of Canterbury might be asked to be present to be reported to for the General Synod.
